A big thank you to our amazing staff, team work really does make the dream work!

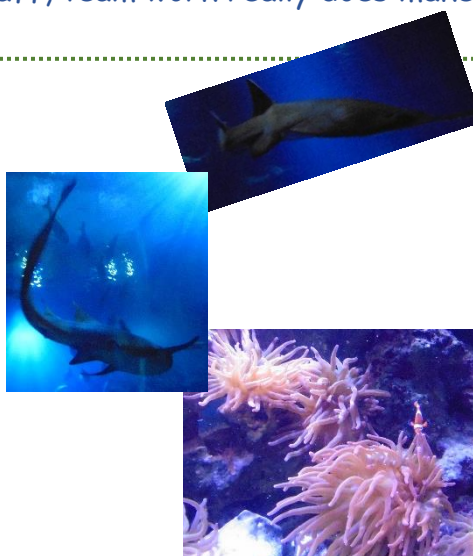
Enrichment Update
